## Step 1 - Open General Settings


Tap “Settings” then “General” and finally “VPN”

## Step 2 - Tap on “Add VPN Configuration”

This brings you to the different protocols available for VPN. These options are IPSec, L2TP and PPTP. Choose one, for example, IPSec.

## Step 3 - Enter Administrator Credentials

Each of the protocols needs some additional information in order to be configured successfully. This can be obtained from your network administrator.
