Step 1 Tap the "Calendar" app on your home screen.

Tap the "Month" button.

You will now see the entire month on your screen.

Touch the date that you would like to add events for. The app screen will show the events for that day. Tap the forward or backward arrow to move ahead or back one day at a time.

Tapping the "List" button will show events in a vertical list, organized by date. You can swipe your finger up or down to scroll through the list.

Tap the "+" to add an appointment or event.
