How to take a panoramic photo on your iPhone or iPad

If you have ever found yourself taking a walk in the outdoors just to find a perfect sight that has to be remembered but found out that taking a simple photo can't capture the whole view, don't worry – the panoramic photo option on your iPhone/iPad is here for you!

Step 1 -

First, open the Camera app on your device

Next, tap on the options button.

There should be three options, choose the Panorama setting.

After that, an arrow with instructions should appear, move your phone horizontally in the direction of the arrow to take the panoramic photo. The slower you move your phone, the better the photo will be. If you want to change the direction, simply tap on the arrow.
