

Fix a Missing Personal Hotspot in iOS 8

Overview

[If Personal Hotspot disappears from your Settings screen in iOS 8, you have to re-enable it before you can turn your phone into a personal hotspot. This tutorial explains how to enable Personal Hotspot again.]

Step 1 - Tap Settings > Cellular

Step 2 - Tap Cellular Data Network

Cellular Data Network will only be visible if your carrier allows it.

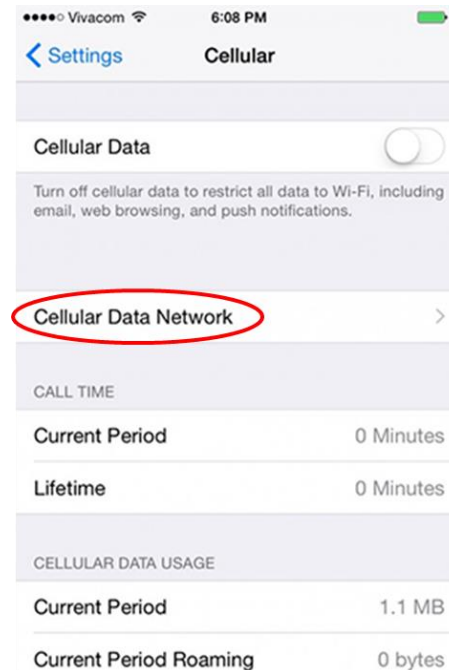


Step 3 - Scroll down to PERSONAL HOTSPOT, enter “test” in the username field, and tap Return
